

Black Student Union's *One More* Scholarship 2025-26 Academic Year

The *One More* scholarship was created in 2014 by the Black Student Union of Puget Sound in order to alleviate some of the barriers to pursuing higher education for fellow students of color by providing financial support. The *One More* scholarship provides a Logger Store gift card to recipients for books and technology. Students can use the gift card for textbooks, electronics, or other classroom necessities available at the Logger Store or ordered with support from the Logger Store staff.

While the exact scholarship amounts have yet to be determined, in the past we have awarded an average amount of \$1,500 per student. Posse Scholars as well as students whose demonstrated financial need is being met with the TPS, Access, or Early Decision commitment are not eligible, as Puget Sound scholarships must go towards unmet need.

Eligible recipients are current Puget Sound students who will be enrolled for the 2025-26 academic year, file a 2025-26 FAFSA, demonstrate financial need, and are a member of an underrepresented population on campus.
